

2009 Child Care Rates
Cost Survey Conducted by City of Boulder
Department of Housing & Human Services
Children, Youth & Families Division

The data presented is based on a survey conducted in the fall of 2008 of 127 child care centers and school age sites in Boulder County. One-hundred ten responses were received (87% response rate). Thirty additional centers were not surveyed (10 that are federally subsidized programs which offer free or reduced child care, 2 centers that focuses on drop-in and/or temporary emergency child care, 5 centers which operate on sliding scale fees, 6 private schools, and 7 part-time programs). Fifty-four part-time preschool facilities were also not surveyed.
