

2009 Child Care Rates
Cost Survey Conducted by City of Boulder
Department of Housing & Human Services
Children, Youth & Families Division

The data presented is based on a survey conducted in the fall of 2008 of 139 licensed family child care homes in Boulder County. 109 responses were received (78% response rate). Fourteen additional homes were not surveyed as they offer only part-time programs.
