



KEY GOALS AND STRATEGIES

Reduce risks to the community.

- Conduct a community risk analysis.
- Update the wildfire protection plan.
- Provide pre-incident planning.
- Add hazardous materials and fire-code inspectors.

Create a stronger organization.

- Develop a succession plan for key management positions and to ensure highly skilled and experienced firefighters.
- Expand training programs, including for certification.
- Upgrade recruitment, grant funding, and other administrative programs.

Improve firefighter safety.

- Increase the number of firefighters to meet acceptable service standards.
- Improve coordination and communication at emergency scenes.
- Upgrade traffic and communications systems for emergency response.

Improve our facilities and equipment.

- Complete the fire training center in order to provide more cost-efficient and effective local training.
- Upgrade or replace deficient facilities and equipment.
- Identify new need areas for fire stations based on changes in growth/development/population.
- Relocate and expand Station 3 to improve safety and response time (see map).
- Identify funding to improve services and address needs.

Partner with the community in more effective outreach for public safety.

- Expand public education efforts.
