



2009 Junior Golf Program

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This program is designed to introduce girls and boys to the game of golf, as well as develop experienced junior players. Basic instruction in all aspects of the game is given in a group clinic setting. Limited individual instruction is provided by P.G.A. Member and Apprentice Golf Professional staff instructors and over 40 trained volunteers. Juniors are also introduced to the rules, etiquette and general play of the game.

The strength of this program is providing a period of time each week when the golf course is open only to juniors. This provides the unique opportunity to learn not only on the practice areas, but on the golf course as well. Flatirons is proud to be one of the only facilities in the country to dedicate the entire golf course each Friday morning exclusively to juniors.

Juniors are grouped by age and ability. Because the safety of the juniors is our number one priority, enrollment for each team will be limited.

Team Green: is for junior golfers age 8-11. Team Green meets at the golf course at 8:30. Team Green features 45 minutes of PGA instruction clinics followed by an hour and 15 minutes of supervised, instructional on-course play. Cost for Team Green Program is \$80.

Team Blue: is for junior golfers ages 10-13. Team Blue meets at the golf course at 7:30. Team Blue features 45 minutes of PGA instruction clinics followed by two hours and 15 minutes of supervised, instructional on-course play. Cost for Team Blue Program is \$100.

Team Black: is for more experienced junior golfers. Team Black meets at the golf course at 6:30. Team Black features 1 hour of PGA instruction clinics followed by three hours on-course play. Team Black juniors must have the ability to play 18 holes without supervision. Cost of Team Black Program is \$125.

Team Double Black: The Double Black Program is for those juniors who are interested in playing competitive golf as well as receiving instruction. Juniors who play or expect to play high school golf should give serious consideration to joining the Double Black Program. The Double Black Program is comprised of the Flatirons Friday Team Black Program, the Flatirons Junior League, the Flatirons Tournament Series and additional instructional clinics. The cost ranges from \$245 to \$515 depending on the level of participation. What equipment is needed?

Tennis or spike-less golf shoes should be worn. Soccer, baseball, or other types of turf shoes are not allowed. All other equipment is provided if needed.

What if we need clubs?

Starter sets are available to all juniors at no charge. These loaner clubs may be picked up at the golf shop. The clubs need to be returned at the final Friday morning session. As it is imperative that all juniors have their clubs before the first session on June 5th, please call the golf shop to arrange a time to pick up the clubs.

What if the weather is bad?

In case of inclement weather causes the cancellation of one session (at the golf shop's discretion) we will have a make up day on Friday, July 31st.

What if we go on vacation or miss a session?

Due to family vacations and other summer activities, we expect that most participants will miss one or more sessions, and the program is designed and priced accordingly.

As a parent, what can I contribute?

Parents are needed as markers and general volunteers. Golf experience is a plus but your experience with children's behaviors is the most valuable experience. Please indicate your interest on the registration form or contact the golf shop.

What if our junior golfer wants more instruction?

For juniors wanting more instruction than is provided through the Friday morning program, both private lessons and one-day group clinics are available to juniors through the golf shop.
