



## Waterless Urinals

### What is a waterless urinal?

It is a urinal that does not require water to function. A waterless urinal uses gravity to capture urine in a plastic trap and direct it through a biodegradable liquid sealant. The sealant is designed to collect the urine and eliminate odor. After the urine runs through the sealant, it passes through a standard drainpipe the same way a conventional urinal functions.

Costs	Savings
1. Installation	1. Less expensive to install than standard toilets and are easily retrofitted.
2. Replacement of plastic trap and sealant.	2. Decrease in water costs
3. Hardware replacement- cost is dependent on what model is chosen.	3. Maintenance costs decrease, plus less plumbing, no flush valves.
