Antifreeze Recycling

Most municipalities prohibit disposing of antifreeze down the sanitary sewer, and it should never be poured down a storm drain.

Safety-Kleen	(303) 761-8614	50¢ per gallon, but customers can receive discounts based upon the amount of service Safety-Kleen provides them.
Raptor Oil	(970) 301-0860	About 55¢ per gallon depending on location, minimum of 100 gallons.
Clear Choice	(303) 227-9900	No charge to pick up used antifreeze if you are a Clear Choice antifreeze customer. Otherwise, it is \$25 for the first 55-gallon drum, and \$12.50 for each additional 55-gallons.
Mesa Oil	(303) 426-4777	50¢ per gallon for pick-up. Will give you a 55-gallon drum if needed for a \$20 deposit.
All Around Antifreeze Recycling	(719) 471-2119	Free pick-up if you purchase recycled anti-freeze from them.

Oil Filter Recyclers

Auto repair shops must recycle their spent oil filters for PACE certification. Spent oil filters are typically stored in 55-gallon drums that hold on average 200 un-crushed filters or 400 crushed filters.

Tri State Oil	(303) 825-0742	\$65 per 55-gallon drum for uncrushed or crushed filters. Also handle waste oil.
Mesa Oil	(303) 426-4777	\$95 per 55-gallon drum for crushed or un-crushed filters. Also handle waste oil. Prices vary with the amount of other service.
Safety Kleen	(303) 761-8614	\$300 per 55-gallon drum for crushed or uncrushed filters. Also offer bin that holds up to 6 55-gallon drums - \$85 per 55-gallon drum plus a \$200 set-up fee for uncrushed or crushed filters. Prices vary with the amount of other service. Also handle waste oil.
Thermo Fluids	(303) 393-1118	\$50 per 55-gallon drum for uncrushed or crushed filters. Also handle waste oil.

Oil Filter Crusher Equipment

Using an oil filter crusher is quick and easy, and removes the most possible oil from your filters. Simply draining the filter leaves up to 44% of the oil in the filter.

Safety-Kleen/ John Cutshall	(303) 761-1365	Safety-Kleen Model 35 uses 100,000 pounds of force to crush filters and squeeze out over 9 ounces of oil per filter in as little as 30 seconds. One drum can hold as much as four drums of uncrushed filters.
